Young Innovators Guidance Notes

About the prize

Clarion Housing Group is looking for **innovative**, **bright ideas** from young people aged between **16 and 25 years** to make a **positive impact** on a community.

We are seeking **new and creative** ways to tackle issues or challenges under four key themes.

2021/22 Young Innovator Themes:

- Environment and Sustainability
- Youth Homelessness
- Age-Friendly Communities
- Clarion Young Resident Ideas

The winning ideas will be matched with a community partner who will receive and host up to £5,000 to turn the idea into a reality.

The winning young people will have access to mentoring and skills building alongside support to develop the entry idea.

What types of ideas can be submitted?

We are looking for new, creative and exciting ideas that will make a positive change under one of the four key themes. No idea is too big, or too small! Examples of the types of ideas that could be considered below: these are simply for reference, entries can present any innovative idea, project or concept that addresses a theme focus area in a new and innovative way.

Environment & Sustainability Prize

- Ideas to help build more eco-friendly communities
- Ideas to improve green spaces and the natural environment to create vibrant neighbourhoods
- Ideas for community-based action to tackle climate change
- Ideas for making homes and neighbourhoods more sustainable

Youth Homelessness Prize

- Ideas to support young people at risk of homelessness into independent living
- Ideas to improve access to information and advice for young people at risk of homelessness
- Ideas to support access to opportunities for young people at risk of homelessness e.g. routes to education, training and employment
- Ideas to address the emotional and mental health needs of young people at risk of homelessness

Age-Friendly Communities Prize

- Ideas for projects and activities to build connections in the community between generations
- Ideas for shared community spaces or accommodation to bring generations together
- Ideas for maintaining positive and long lasting connections between generations

Clarion Young Resident Prize

Ideas to improve your neighbourhood or address a challenge faced by you and your peers in your Clarion community.

Who can apply?

- ✓ The William Sutton Prize for Young Innovators is open to individuals aged between 16 and 25 who are resident in the UK.
- ✓ Prize funding for the development and delivery of the winning entries will be hosted by Clarion Futures or a nominated partner organisation. Prize funds cannot be issued to a personal bank account.
- ✓ Applicants may only submit a single application under one of the prize categories. We cannot accept applications under multiple categories from the same entrant.
- ✓ Clarion Housing Group employees are not eligible to apply.
