Fun Day

In the last Barne Barton newsletter news we let you know we are holding a fun day on 8 July from 2.30pm-5.30pm at Tamar View. We hope to see lots of you there!

We appreciate this project has taken longer than we had hoped to get underway so as a thank you for your patience, we will be offering you the opportunity to sign up for a free paint pack to decorate your home with and will also be offering you the chance to book an appointment with a handyperson service.

Handyperson service

The handy person service will be on the estate for two weeks and appointments are on a first come, first served basis. They will be able to do some small jobs for you that wouldn't normally be completed by CBS as a repair.

Here are some of the services the handyperson will be able to provide:

- Fit new taps bought by the tenant
- Fix or fit a new toilet seat
- Fit toilet roll holders
- Hang a shower rail
- Hang mirrors and pictures
- Put up a shelf
- Change a light bulb
- Fit curtain poles
- Put together flat pack furniture
- Small plaster repairs in readiness for decoration

There will be a 'handyperson corner' at the event so for more information please come to talk to us about your requirements. CBS will also be at the event and will be able to advise if any jobs should be reported as a repair instead and to help you do that.

Paint pack

A paint pack entitles you to receive paint and the other items like brushes, rollers, masking tape and dust sheets that you will need to decorate your home. You will be able to choose enough equipment and paint to do one room, or several.

If you would like to receive a free paint pack please collect a form from the 'paint pack corner' and Pippa and Anita in our local team will help you to complete it. We'll then order the paint direct with Crown and they'll contact you to confirm your choices and arrange delivery.

You will also be able to register for a paint pack after the event up until the 21 July by calling 0300 100 0303 and asking to speak to Pippa.

You will need to bring proof of address with you to pick up your FREE voucher for the BBQ and if you want to book the handyperson service or pick up your paint pack.

Masterplan
