We have now submitted an outline planning application for the Eastfields master plan to Merton Council. This includes details about the number of homes, layout and vehicle access for the Eastfields master plan. Merton Council will decide whether to approve the outline planning application once the Estates Local Plan is in place.

If the planning application is approved we'll work on the detailed design of each phase and hire a building contractor.
