Regeneration update

In April 2017 we submitted an outline planning application for the Eastfields master plan to Merton Council. This includes details about the proposed number of homes, layout of buildings and how vehicles will move around. A decision about the planning application will be made once Merton Council has approved its Estates Local Plan towards the end of this year.
