Redevelopment of the Sutton Estate: Project Update

Proposals for the redevelopment of the Sutton Estate are making good progress and the project team continue to be busy working on the designs in liaison with the Royal Borough of Kensington (RBKC) and the Resident Steering Group.

Before we submit a formal planning application, we will share the proposals with you and the wider public. Details of these events will be available soon.

The project team recently met with the local ward councillors, who hope to meet with tenants at one of the forthcoming Resident Steering Group meetings. And in early October, members of the Chelsea Society visited the Estate to talk through the proposals with the project team.

Sutton Estate Road Trip

Members of the Steering Group were joined by a small number of fellow tenants who were able to take up the spare places on a first come first serve basis.

The Lavenders is currently undergoing redevelopment and this site visit was a great opportunity to see an Estate under development first hand. To fund the new homes, there are also some homes for private sale at The Lavenders. Plus there is a fantastic purpose built community centre.

We set off from the Estate at 11am and on arrival at The Lavenders had a tour, which included improvements to the walk alongside the River Wandle. Tenants then viewed some empty properties to get an idea of the size and quality of the new accommodation that has been built.

Afterwards, lunch was enjoyed by all in the new community centre, where tenants met Brian, who was a member of The Lavenders Resident Steering Group, and Bob Beaumont, who is the scheme's Project Director.




For those unable to make it, we have also provided a guide to the moving process enclosed with this newsletter.
